
Judkins Light Rail Station (opening 2024) is within walking distance making Rainier Ave S a vital connection between Downtown Seattle and Bellevue.



With a perfect 91 walk score and excellent 89 ride score, the site enjoys quick access to bus lines and the opening of the Judkins Park Light Rail Station and RapidRide lines in 2024. Blocks from the Seattle Street Car and close to 4,000 new residential units within 0.6 mile radius.

WALKING DISTANCE TO JUDKINS LIGHT RAIL STATION

The Judkins Park light rail station opens in 2024 and will be the East Link's first station after exiting the Downtown Seattle Transit Tunnel and heading across Lake Washington toward Bellevue. Judkin Station's West entrance sits on Rainier Avenue South.

The Judkins Light Rail Station will sit between two new RapidRide lines—one on Rainier Ave S starting 2024. The station will likely see many transfers from Rainier Valley and Central Area-based RapidRide riders going to/from the Eastside or downtown.

The City of Seattle's 4.2 million dollar transportation improvement project to Rainier Avenue South includes new dedicated bus lanes, improved crossing/signage/signal upgrades, and a reduced speed limit.
